How to register as a volunteer:

1

Apply for a role in the job bank

You must apply for and be assigned a volunteer role before you can complete your registration.
The minimum age to volunteer is 18.

2

Talk to a volunteer coordinator

A responsible contact from the section you have applied to will get in touch to clarify tasks, hours and expectations.

3

Safe from harm and letter of confirmation

All volunteers must complete a safe from harm course and a letter that confirm your connection to your local scout union.

4

Complete the volunteer registration

Once you have completed the application process, you will receive a welcome email containing a link to the volunteer registration form. Here you register your days, accommodation, meals and any preferred subcamp.

What does it cost to volunteer?



Pre-camp and post-camp

If you only take part in precamp or postcamp – and not during the main jamboree – it is free to volunteer. You must bring your own tent and equipment for sleeping. We provide the food.

You must still register by applying for a volunteer role for the precamp and postcamp. You must also have a criminal records disclosure certificate to volunteer at the precamp and postcamp.



One day - volunteer

It is **free** to register as a day volunteer when you do not wish to stay at the jamboree. Accommodation and meals are not included when you register as a day volunteer during the period 18 –26 July. We therefore encourage you to bring your own lunch bag or buy food from one of the jamboree's food trucks. You can also buy a meal ticket for the volunteers' canteen.



Under 40 hours

If you live and eat at the jamboree and work fewer than 40 hours, you pay the regular participant fee. Remember that you must still register as a volunteer, even if you are already registered as a participant with your group.



40+ hours

If you are at least 15 years old and volunteer for at least 40 hours before, during or after the jamboree, your participant fee is reduced by 30%. This fee includes access to all jamboree infrastructure, shower facilities, three meals a day and shared transport to and from the jamboree. The discount must be approved by your committee head.



Check-in on arrival

27/6 - 10/7

The dining tent at Tranemosevej 2

Meals are served at the same location throughout this period.

2

11/7 - 17/7

The information tent in subcamp Skoven (the forrest)

The canteen in Skoven is open during this period.

3

15/7 - 17/7

Information tent in subcamp Landet (the countryside)

The canteen in Landet is also open.

4

18/7 - 26/7

The information tent in the subcamp where you will be staying

All volunteers must check in on arrival. If you are going to eat in a volunteer canteen, you will be given a wristband showing which canteen you will use.

You cannot check in at the Information Centre at Spejdertorvet.

5

Postcamp

Check-in at the canteens

26/7 lunch – 29/7 breakfast: subcamp Skoven

29/7 lunch – 3/8: Tranemosevej 2



When you arrive at check-in

Please state your name, details of your registration and, if applicable, which group you belong to. If something in your registration is not correct, it must be clarified immediately.

At check-in you will be given:

Skejser wristband

Canteen and shower wristbands

Volunteer scarf*

Water bottle*

Jamboree badge

Parking permit, if applicable

**Volunteer scarf and water bottle are only given to volunteers who work more than eight hours. Relatives of volunteers do not receive a scarf or water bottle.*

Take good care of your volunteer scarf! Only one scarf is issued per person, and we cannot replace it if you lose it.



Food and canteens

- Volunteers with meals included eat either in the volunteer canteens or with their own group, depending on what you requested in your registration. Check your volunteer registration overview to see where you will eat, or ask when you arrive.
- Your canteen wristband shows which canteen you should eat in. Take good care of it. If you change canteens during the jamboree, you can get a new wristband in the information tent in the subcamp where you will eat.
- As a rule, day volunteers do not have meals included. You can bring a lunch bag, buy food from food trucks or buy a meal ticket for the canteen via the information tents in the subcamps.

Opening hours of the four subcamp canteens (18 –26 July):

06.30–09.00, 11.30–14.00 and 17.00–20.00.

Special opening hours apply during precamp and postcamp. Not all canteens are open. Check your volunteer registration to see which canteens you should eat in and when. You may need to change canteen during the jamboree.

Overnight stay at the jamboree

- You can choose to stay with your guide or scout group if the group is registered for the jamboree.
- If you are not staying with a group, you can stay in one of the four volunteer camps located in the four subcamps: Skoven (the forrest), Landet (the countryside), Havet (the sea) and Byen (the city).
- HOTELT is an overnight option for volunteers located at Spejdertorvet, where you can reserve a tent for the main jamboree for the nights 18/7–25/7, and for a limited number of nights during precamp 15/7–17/7.

- The family camp works like a caravan site, where you can bring your tent, caravan or motorhome. You can stay there while you are a volunteer or guest at the jamboree. The family camp is open from 18 –26 July.

Enjoy your shower...

Shower facilities are **free** for all volunteers. If you have a canteen wristband, it also serves as access to the shower area. If you do not have a canteen



Where will I stay and eat?

How do I find out which canteen(s) I will eat in at the jamboree and which subcamp I will sleep in?

1. Go to <https://jobs.spejdernelejr.dk/>
2. Click on "Volunteer log in" in the top right corner and log in via the membership system.
3. Under "My page" you will find the box "Volunteer registration".
4. Click on "Download PDF overview".
5. A PDF will now be downloaded to your computer.

When you open the PDF, you will see an overview of which days you are registered, where you will eat, where you will stay and other information you have provided in your volunteer registration.



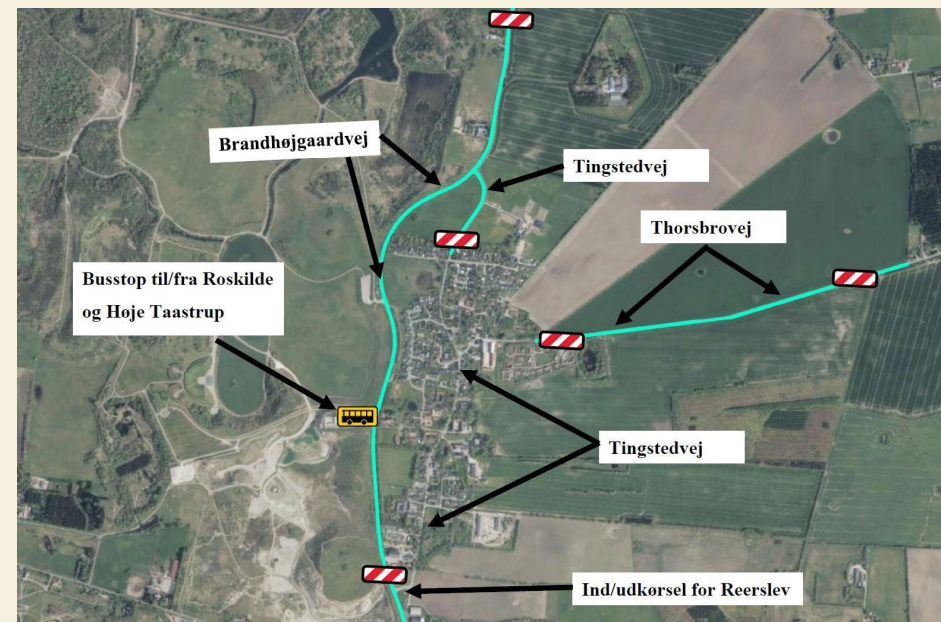
Transport, traffic and parking area

- All participants and volunteers are offered shared transport; use it if it suits your role.
- City buses run 19 –25 July between the jamboree and Roskilde Station and Høje Taastrup Station. The bus stop at the jamboree is on Tranemosevej close to Reerslev Church. City buses require payment.
- Expect heavy traffic on 18 and 26 July, when many arrive and travel home. Follow the guidance shared on the website and in the information packs.
- Consider whether driving is really necessary on the main changeover days, when participants also need to get to and from the jamboree.

- **Parking is free for all volunteers.**

Parking area address: Thorsbrovej 17 T

You can drive anywhere on the jamboree site until 17/7 at 22.00. If you arrive after the jamboree has started, you must collect your parking permit at check-in. Once you have your volunteer parking permit and your number plate has been registered, you are free to drive in and out of the parking area.



Tip: Plan your arrival time and transport together with your committee, especially if you are arriving before the main jamboree.

Payment and Skejser

Payment options at the jamboree

Shops, kiosks and stalls accept Visa/Dankort, Visa, MasterCard, Apple Pay, Google Pay and American Express. If you have a payment card, it is the easiest solution for you and the most economical for the jamboree if you use it. So please use your card – and if you do not have a card, use Skejser.

CampOS ID (volunteers)

Volunteers can find their participant number/CampOS ID under "My page" in the registration system. You will need this number when you create your Skejser wristband.

Skejser

All participants will receive a wristband with a chip that can be used as a means of payment. We call this Skejser. In this way, we avoid using cash at the jamboree. The colour of your Skejser wristband depends on whether you are over or under 18 years old.

Closing Your Skejser Account

Your Skejser account will be closed after the jamboree. If there is money left in the account, you can choose between the following options:

Donate the remaining amount to Jamboree Denmark 2026 by logging onto your account no later than 6 August 2026.

Have the remaining amount automatically refunded a few weeks after the jamboree. The remaining amount will be returned to the card most recently used for payment.

Get an overview of your tasks

Many teams and committees use the jamboree's shared duty scheduling system – Crewnet.

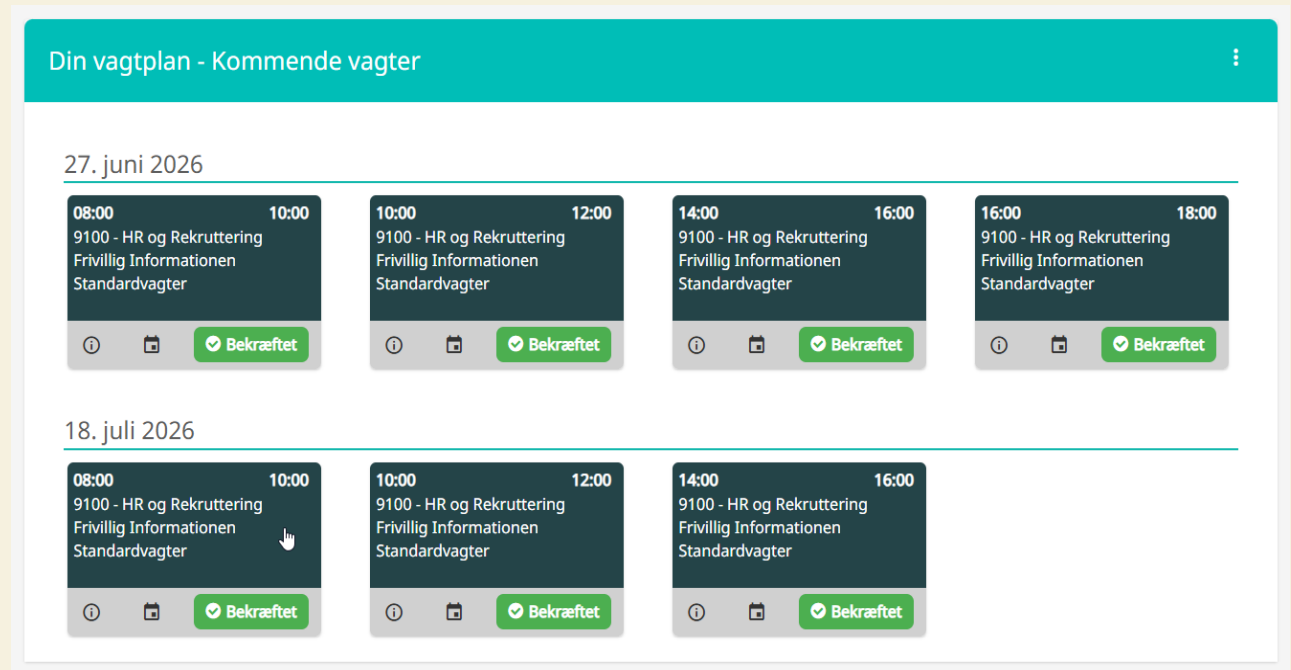
Log in by clicking the button:

To log in, simply use the same details you used when registering for the jamboree.

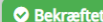
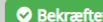
View your duty schedule

To see your duty schedule, click on the menu item [Your duty schedule], after which you will see an overview of your upcoming shifts, as shown here:

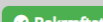
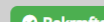
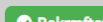

Volunteer community and well-being

The phone is open 24/7 from 18–26 July

- Did you know that we have a large **volunteer lounge** in the Administrative Square? Drop by to relax, hold meetings, make new friends, play a game or get creative. We have also created a small children's corner for those bringing their child to the jamboree.
The volunteer lounge is also the place where you can create your own merch with textile printing on recycled fabrics or on clothes you bring yourself, and where you can decorate your water bottle with stickers.
- **Opening hours in the volunteer lounge:**
 - Saturday 18 July: 13.00–22.00
 - Sunday 19 July to Saturday 25 July: 9.00–12.00 and 13.00–22.00



Working Environment and Safety

If you are unsure about a task, a tool or a safety rule, always ask your supervisor before you start. It is better to ask once too often than once too little.

Briefly about the rules for volunteer work

- Volunteer work is generally covered by health and safety regulations, and the work must be planned and carried out in a safe and healthy way.
- Clear instructions and relevant training must be given before a task is carried out.
- Volunteers may only perform tasks they have been introduced to and that they can complete safely.
- Hazardous tasks, heavy lifting, machinery, chemicals or work with particular risks require extra assessment, instruction and the right conditions.
- Young people under 18 are subject to special rules on work tasks, working hours and supervision.

Important: At Jamboree Denmark 2026 you cannot volunteer if you are under 15 years old!

What we expect at Jamboree Denmark 2026

- You always follow the instructions from your leader or responsible coordinator.
- You speak up if a task seems unsafe, unclear or too demanding.
- You use equipment correctly and only for the purposes you have been instructed in.
- You help prevent accidents by keeping things tidy, being aware of your surroundings and reacting to risks.
- You look after yourself and others by taking breaks, drinking water and speaking up if you feel overloaded.
- Accidents, near-misses and dangerous situations must be reported immediately to the responsible person.
- A positive tone, respectful behaviour and a safe community are an important part of the working environment.



If an accident happens

- Always follow instructions from the emergency services, traffic staff, area management and your volunteer coordinator.
- In case of serious injury or signs of illness, you can contact the jamboree hospital. Visits to the jamboree hospital, casualty clinics and emergency services are free for all jamboree participants, regardless of nationality. Remember to bring ID.

Important phone numbers at the jamboree

- The jamboree has its own control centre, which you can contact if you need help (ambulance, fire and rescue).

Use this emergency number in situations where you would normally call 112.
- **Operations centre: +45 7060 1626**
Non-urgent calls should be made to the operations centre. This could be, for example, requests for craftsperson assistance or reporting faults in installations.
