Shared activity teams

Groups within the same subcamp can create joint activity teams

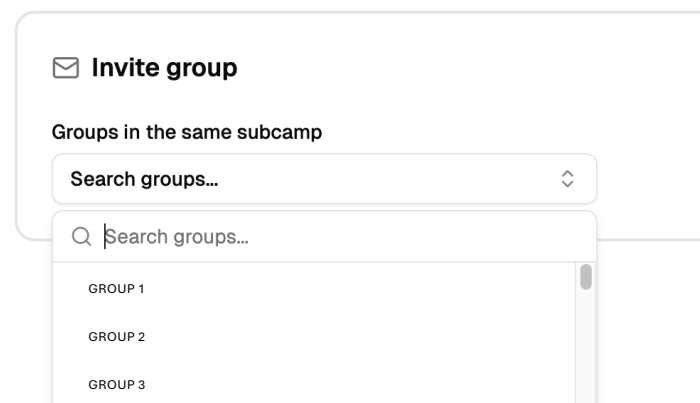
One group must create and host the team

Only the group that creates the team can wish for activities and prioritize them. The invited group(s) can see the list of participants and add/remove their own guides/scouts

The host group must invite the other groups

Click  and invite other groups

It is possible to invite several groups for the team



Invited groups will have to accept the invite in the "Teams" tab

You have to accept or deny the invite

If one or more invited groups have accepted the invitation then the team cannot be deleted, unless all groups remove their participants. Then the host group can delete the team.

Team for "adults"



After many requests from participants, we have updated the system, to allow participants to both be leader of one team, and participants on another team – a team for ‘Senior / Clan / Rover team’, and whoever you might want to have on these teams for grown scouts (no age restriction).

Mark the ‘Senior / Clan / Rover team’.

ALL participants on the team will now be considered a normal participant on this team, which means there will be no leader-function for this team.

In the system these teams will be shown with a purple tag, instead of yellow.

Each group can make as many of these "adult" teams as they wish to, but each participant can only be signed up for one. It is possible to be a member of this team without also being a leader of another team. The system will not allow each person to be recognised as participant on more than one team.



If a team contains participants across the standard age division, then ensure the selection for age-matching activities to view all activities is not active.

Only show age-matching activities

We recommend that you use the catalogue of activities to decide what you want to wish for. The activities can then be found in the wish list system by using the search function.

If active, then only activities with an age range fitting the entire team will be shown. A single participant outside the age range will lead to an activity not being shown.

When choosing one or more participants press

Add to signup team

to add them to an activity team

‘Camp days’ shows the days where each participant is registered at the camp

The team can only be assigned activities on days where all participants are registered.

Click Remove from signup team to remove a participant from a team

Click to assign a participant as the leader of the team

As a leader your age is not included for the age recommended activities, nor in the weekly schedule for when participants are present at camp and thus eligible for activity assignment. The activities state if leaders are requested to help at the activity, can participate with the team or not.
